MINUTES OF THE IQAC MEETING

IQAC meeting held on 31st March 2017 and 1st April 2017.

- 1. Vice-Principal Dr. M.M. Chikodikar welcomed the IQAC members and welcomed the resource person Principal Dr. Rawal of BMCC College, Pune. He informed the members that his college will become autonomous soon and that Prof. Rawal received Best Principal Award of Pune University, for this academic year.
- 2. The slideshow of various college activities were shown by Vice-Principal.
- Principal P.M. Bhende briefed resource person that he has decided to make Personality Development courses for F.Y.B.Com. students annually. As Also a Research Methodology workshop/course for M.Com. students will also be made compulsory.
- 4. Principal informed that college will gear up for third cycle of NAAC scheduled for March 2020. He said that by October 2019 the SSR will be ready and a mock Peer Team Inspection will be conducted.
- 5. Principal spoke about 3 Projects involving community and society which have been started in our college.
 - a) Paper Bag and Cloth Bag making by college NSS unit for sale at a nominal price to traders in Ponda.
 - b) Basic computer Literacy for Housewives in Ponda. This project is yet to start.
 - c) College to adopt village Panchayats and help them in improving their socio-economic development.
- Prof. Rawal based on said PPT based and on SWOT analysis and recommendations of 2nd NAAC Peer Team said a short term and a perspective plan for 10-15 years should be prepared. He also
 - said from 1st July NAAC parameters, methodology in calculating Grade and Score of a college will change. Quantitative analysis will be done and verified through stakeholders.
 - Rawal Sir appreciated village adoption. He also said his college did it. Strategy: Conduct a NSS Program. Economics Department can conduct a socio-economic profile of the village. Find out the merits, strengths and weaknesses of the villages and if there is water shortage then your college helps the village by approaching the PWD department, approaching Local MLA in resolving the water scarcity problem.
- 7. One more suggestion was to take a feedback about Non-teaching staff by students and then feedback is analysed. Prepare questionnaire (a need based one) on office staff, teaching staff functioning and services and analyse it and any negative feedback should be used to fine tune the working of office and teaching staff. There should be board in front of office with names of office staff and Peons, their

designation and work duty and timing of the office. He said a plan of action w.r.t. criteria 1 to 7 based on recommendations and SWOT analysis must be done.

- Formalise the feedback system from students, parents, teachers, employers and feedback is analysed, shared and suggestions.
- Analysis of results from Semester-I should be done.
- Backlog/Failure, Border pass class students- slow learners remedial; bridge courses should be recommended.
- Student centric system of learning, teaching.
