ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON THE FEEDBACK FROM THE STAKEHOLDERS

Institution obtained feedback on the academic performance and ambience of the institution from the stakeholders, such as Students, Faculty, Alumni, Employers. Analysis of the feedback obtained from the stakeholders indicated the areas wherein institution needed improvement. After considering the suggestions from the stakeholders, IQAC Co-ordinator discussed the matter with the staff members and following plan of action was framed:

1. According to the stakeholders more certificated or add-on courses for skill enhancement are to be conducted. Accordingly, faculty members were instructed to conduct at least one certificate course for skill enhancement.
2. In order to make teaching-learning exciting it was decided to organise more seminars, workshops and guest lectures. Faculty were instructed to organise at least two guest lectures every semester in their respective course.
3. It was decided to consider involvement of alumni for conducting certificate courses and guest lectures.
4. In order to enforce experiential and contextual learning it is decided to conduct at least one industrial visit/field trip for the students of each division and to promote outstation industrial tours.
5. MOUs provide a structured framework for institutions to work together towards common goals. It was decided that more MOUs are to be signed for the purpose of internship, industrial visits, guest lectures, mini project work etc.
6. The students suggested that the canteen facility needs to be improved. It was decided to discuss the matter with the management and take necessary steps to improve canteen facilities.
7. The students also raised an issue on garden and seating space on college campus.



Action taken Report
