Students Satisfaction Survey Analysis

Academic Year 2022 - 23(B.Com. Programme)

The Students Satisfaction Survey is a useful and effective instrument that tries to focus on areas which require improvement. Students satisfaction survey was conducted at the end of the Academic Year 2022 - 23 to evaluate the satisfaction of the students on areas such as faculty performance, evaluation and assessment, library facility, infrastructure and institutional support system. Feedback from 198 students was collected by distributing structured questionnaire. Students from all three classes i.e F.Y.B.Com., S.Y.B.Com. and T.Y.B.Com were included in the survey. This report gives detailed analysis of the survey.

The analysis indicated that the main reason for choosing this college was the good reputation of the college. Another reason for admission was recommendation from friends or relatives.

The analysis revealed that students find B.Com. programme rich and challenging. They are happy with the choice of the subject available and adequacy of subjects included in the programme. The students felt that B.Com. programme will provide them employment opportunities. Most of the students agreed that the faculty encourages students participation in NCC. NSS and also co-curricular/extra—curricular activities.

According to students, faculty are knowledgeable and skilled, punctual, engage lectures assigned to them and are come well prepared for the class. Faculty covers syllabus well in time and were able to communicate the contents of the subjects effectively. With regard to solving difficulties on the subject, the faculty was helpful. According to students, faculty was good at identifying strengths and weaknesses of the students. Students felt that efforts were made by the faculty to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills. Most of the faculty used ICT tools for teaching. Overall, the students were satisfied with the quality of teaching- learning process.

Students satisfaction on evaluation and assessment was very high. According to students examination dates are notified well in advance and results are declared well in time. Almost, all the students were satisfied with the assessment and evaluation in ISA and SEE.

Students satisfaction of library facility was very high. According to them, library is well equipped with a variety of books and study material as well as e-resources. The students agreed that the library staff helps in accessing books and e-resources.

According to majority of the students, classrooms are ICT enabled and college has good computer laboratories. Also, campus is wi-fi enabled. Many of the students felt that college needs a better audio-visual room. Most of the students felt that sports, canteen and wash rooms facilities were inadequate.



According to the students, administrative staff is supportive and counselling and mentoring facilities available are good.

The analysis revealed that most of the students would like to pursue higher studies after graduation or take up work/job. Very few of them would prefer being self employed.

Areas that need improvement:

Sports and canteen facilities to be improved.



KEY OBSERVATIONS:

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Feedback Analysis 2022-23

Students chose G.V.M.'s G.G.P.R College primarily based on its positive reputation and the quality of faculty. Some indicated other personal reasons for their choice. Many selected the M.Com. program due to their interest in the subject and the promising employment opportunities it offers. A significant portion also mentioned the scope for further studies as a motivator.

Overall, respondents expressed satisfaction with the program's challenging nature and the availability of diverse subjects. They felt that the program curriculum was well-suited for employment and emphasized a good learning experience. Some positive aspects included teachers providing information on competencies and course outcomes and encouraging participation in cocurricular activities.

Faculty members were praised for their knowledge, punctuality, and effective teaching methods. They were noted for their good control over the class and timely coverage of syllabus content. Many students also appreciated the faculty's ability to identify strengths and weaknesses in students and promote employability skills.

Assessment was generally considered fair, and timely feedback was appreciated. However, there were concerns about the advance notification of examination dates and result declaration.

Students were satisfied with the variety of books and study materials available in the library. However, opinions were mixed concerning the library's website and e-resources. The library staff was viewed positively in assisting students.

The college's website received mixed reviews, as did classroom cleanliness and ICT enablement. Opinions were diverse on canteen facilities, sports infrastructure, and other amenities.

Administrative staff was generally perceived as supportive, and counseling and mentoring services were rated positively.

The majority of students intend to take up a job, reflecting their interest in pursuing their career and earning a livelihood. Some have plans for self-employment or other diverse future endeavors.

M.Com. program is seen as challenging, employment-oriented, and encourages participation in cocurricular activities. Faculty members are recognized for their knowledge and effective teaching methods. However, there are areas of improvement, including communication and certain infrastructure aspects.
